Directions:

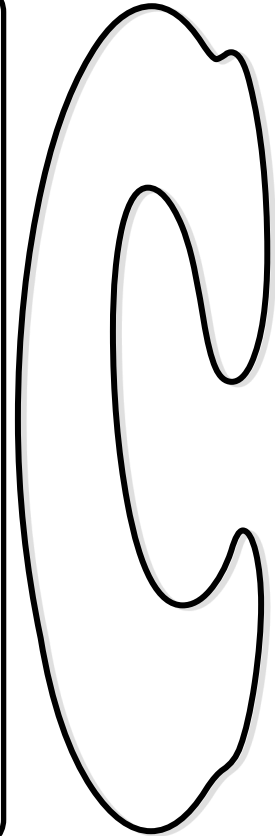
1. Cut along the gray dotted line around each page of the book

Answer: All of the above!



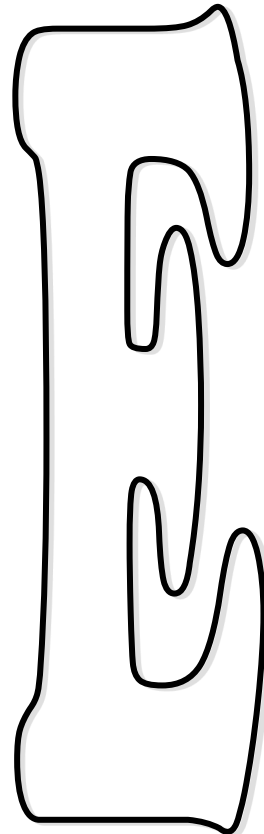

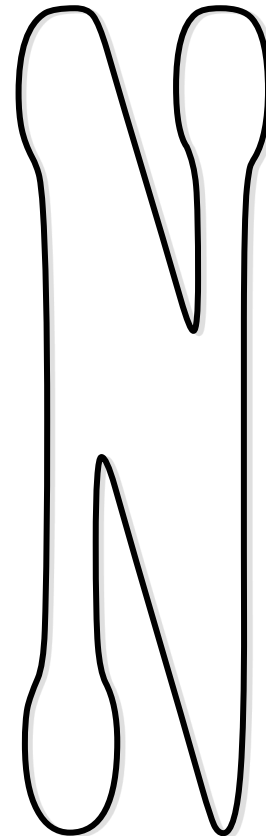

We all make mistakes, just like scientists. Finding the answer is not always easy meaning scientists often make corrections and changes.

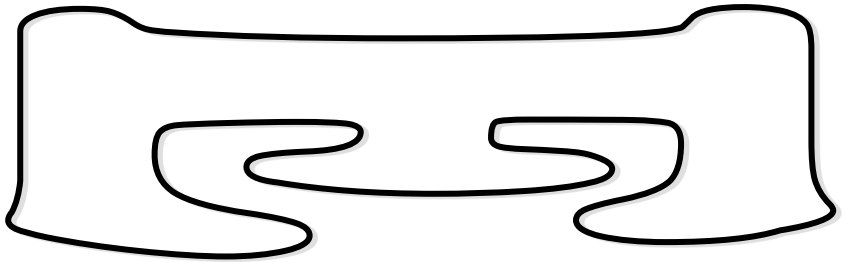
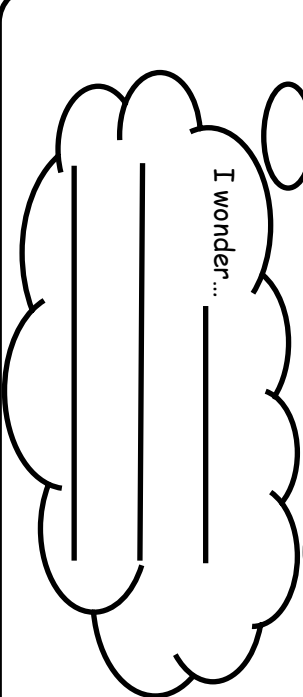
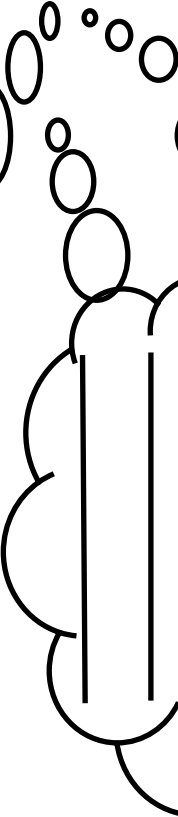
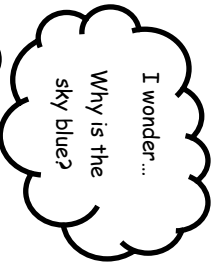
